Under its 2010 contracts, some of Citizant's most significant new assignments include:

- **Project management and data-processing functions for DOJ** – \$17.2 million over five years
- **Enterprise architecture for HUD** – \$9.4 million over five years; \$7.5 additional possible
- **Business process re-engineering and application development for DOJ** – \$2.2 million over 18 months
- **Enterprise architecture services for DHS** – \$4.1 million over 18 months, with an additional \$15.9 million possible over five years
- **Information assurance services for DHS** – \$880,000 over three years
- **Enterprise-wide customer management system for GSA** – \$4.1 million over three years
