



## Citizant Awarded Contract With HUD for Energy Efficiency Grants Reporting System

*\$2.8 million project will leverage previous HUD application development and grants management experience*

Each year, HUD issues grants that total \$2-\$2.5 billion through the Capital Fund program and more than \$700 million annually through the Indian Housing Block Grant and the Indian Community Development Block Grant programs.
